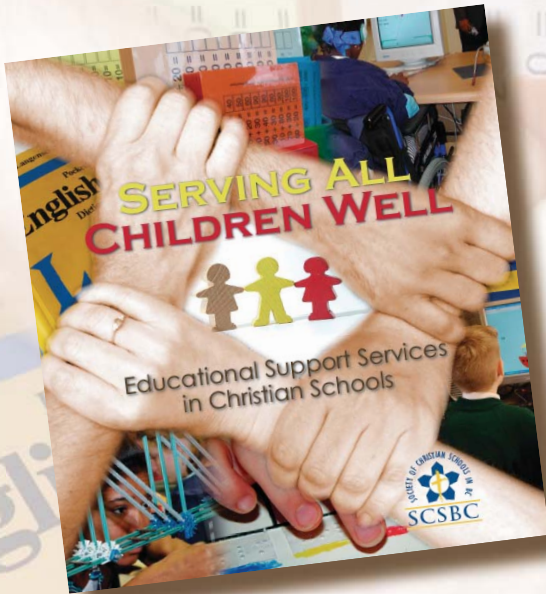


# SERVING ALL CHILDREN WELL
